I understand admission will be on a probationary basis. During the one quarter probationary period, the following expectations must be met:

- Regular attendance at church on the part of the parent(s) and child.
- Enrollment cannot be considered complete until receipt of the previous school records, which indicate:
 - Successful completion of the grade(s) previously claimed.
 - No problems beyond the scope of our staffing and structure.
 - A copy of current health records as required by the State of Illinois.
- Successful review by the teacher, principal and Board of Christian Day School after one quarter.

Should it become evident during the probationary period that St. Paul's Lutheran School is unable to meet the needs of the student, the principal will work with the parents to find the proper placement for the child. All enrollment fees will be returned as well as all unused tuition fees.
