

Policy Committee Meeting

16 May 2011

Recommendation: Rescind the 5 April 2005 guidelines for enforcing the dress code at St. Paul's Lutheran School and incorporate the below enforcement into the uniform policy after the "Uniform Policy Guidelines" section.

The teachers will remind the students to have their shirts tucked in at the beginning of school, at the end of each recess and before chapel.

If the school staff deems that a student is not dressed as per any portion of the established uniform policy, the following steps will be taken:

First Offense: In order to correct the problem, a phone call will be made to the student's parents.

Second and/or Third Offense: Parent(s) will be called and asked to come to the school and meet with the principal. The principal will counsel the parent(s) on the current uniform policy guidelines. If needed, the parent(s) will need to bring appropriate clothing that complies with the uniform policy to school. The student will remain in the office until the parent(s) arrive and meet with the principal.

Fourth Offense: Parent(s) will be called and asked to come to the school and meet with the principal. The principal will counsel the parent(s) on the current uniform policy guidelines. If needed, they will need to bring appropriate clothing to school. The student will remain in the office until the parent(s) arrive and meet with the principal. A meeting will be scheduled for the parent(s) and student to meet with the Board of Christian Day School & ECC.

Any future offense: Student is subject to suspension and/or expulsion as decided by the Board of Christian Day School & ECC.
