*Tuition can be paid in one lump sum on or before July 15 or in ten monthly installments beginning in August. Facts Management Company will handle your budgeted payments according to your selection. If you do not plan to pay in full by the July 15 deadline and are not currently using FACTS, you MUST sign up to use FACTS tuition management.
